FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS: PASTORAL

How many form classes are there in each year group?

We have 4 form classes in each year group.

How many students are usually in a form class?

Our main school classes usually have around 29 to 34 students in the class.

What pastoral support do you have at the school?

Our pastoral structure includes, link Senior Leader, Head of Year and a Learning Coordinator for each year group. We have an Assistant Principal who manages Pastoral and Safeguarding at the school.

What reward systems do you have at the school?

We have weekly shout outs, stars of the week and manners of the week nominations. We also have half termly reward assemblies celebrating excellent efforts, achievement, attendance and behaviour.

Each faculty also has their own rewards for excellent effort and achievement.
