

## **Accessibility Plan**

Our Accessibility Plan sets out how our School will improve equality of opportunity for disabled people. This plan sets out the establishment's proposals to increase access to education for disabled students in the following three areas:

- Increasing the extent to which disabled pupils can participate in the School curriculum;
- Improving the physical environment to enable disabled pupils to take better advantage of education and associated facilities and services; and
- Improving the availability of accessible information to disabled pupils.

The preparation of the Accessibility Plan has been informed by analyses of data within the School and its premises. It is a requirement that the Accessibility Plan is resourced, implemented and reviewed as necessary and at least annually. A copy of this Plan has been placed on our website.
